



## 2023 BUDGET

Butternut Valley Rural Community has received the 2023 budget and tax rates from the Minister of Local Government and Local Governance Reform.

The total tax-base for the new Butternut Valley Rural Community is \$465,660,950 and the 2023 Operating Budget is approximately \$1,351,521. The municipal budget consists of six sub- units, one for each of the former Local Service District (LSD) that now form Butternut Valley.

The tax rates in tables below are calculated per \$100 of property assessment.

Residential Tax Rate - Goes to Butternut Valley and each sub-unit has a different tax rate based on the amount of shared services and local services.

Special Provincial Levy - Transportation services (road maintenance and construction) are provided in the Rural Community directly by the Government of New Brunswick from the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure. Revenues for the provision of this service are made by way of a special provincial levy of \$0.4115.

Services provided by the Minister - An additional amount of \$0.3947 per \$100 is also added to the provincial rate for services provided by the Minister of ELG – which include RCMP/Fire Services and Dangerous and unsightly premises.
